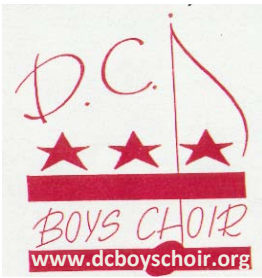

# Directions to St. Paul's Center

## From Downtown D.C.

Follow New Hampshire Avenue **north** to Allison Street, N.W., Make a **right** turn onto Allison Street. Stay on Allison Street for about 3 blocks. Enter the gates to St. Paul's. St. Paul's Center will be the large building on the left.

## From Northwest D.C.

Follow New Hampshire Avenue **south** to Allison Street, N.W. Make a **left** turn onto Allison Street. Stay on Allison Street for about 3 blocks. Enter the gates to St. Paul's. St. Paul's Center will be the large building on the left.
